No, the Department of Health does not need to approve that plan. However, the plan should be created in accordance with guidance from <a href="CMS">CMS</a> and the <a href="Department of Health">Department of Health</a> .			
As a skilled nursing facility, we are aligning with Department of Health and CMS guidance regarding testing. If the county positivity rate on the Department's dashboard differs from the CMS data, which should we use?	Per CMS Interim Final Rule, facilities should use the CMS county positivity rate data.

- On 9/1/2020, Governor Tom Wolf signed a second renewal of his 90-day disaster declaration for the COVID-19 pandemic. Click <a href="here">here</a> for the press release.
- On 9/1/2020, Department of Human Services (DHS) Secretary Teresa Miller and Department of Health (DOH) Secretary Dr. Rachel Levine announced that 100 percent of the 1,363 DHS-licensed assisted living residences, personal care homes, and private intermediate care facilities have completed universal baseline COVID-19 testing by the 8/31/2020 deadline set in Secretary Levine's Order. - If you travel to a state with a high number of COVID-19 cases, it is recommended that you stay at home for 14 days upon return to Pennsylvania. A <u>list of those states</u> has been created and is updated each Friday. On 9/4/2020, the list of states changed. The current list is as follows: Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Hawaii, Idaho, Illinois, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri, Nevada, North Carolina, North Dakota, Oklahoma, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, and Texas.
