We have developed a 50-minute instructional training video showing a step-by-step demonstration of the proper infection prevention and control procedures for wound care. It is titled:

PA-HAI- Demonstrating Wound Care and the Clinician's Role in Preventing Wound Colonization and Infection

The purpose of this training is to increase clinicians' awareness of the significance of wound colonization and infection and demonstrate best practice infection prevention and control techniques to conduct wound care and collect aerobic wound cultures.

- If you have an account, enter Login Name and Password, and click "Login".

- Once logged into TRAIN PA, locate the Search header, and choose "Courses." Near the top of the screen, **enter the course number in "Search TRAIN"**, and press enter.
