# DOH SURVEY RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER PENNSYLVANIA STATUTES AND REGULATIONS

Healthcare Facilities Act 35 P.S. §448.101, et. seq.

- Licensing of hospitals
- Photo identification requirements
- Revocation and nonrenewal or provisional license
- Inspection/survey authority

#### PA Hospital Regulations 28 PA Code §51.1, et seq.

- General provisions regarding governance, management, licensing, change of ownership,
- Medical staffing, nurse staffing, pharmacy and anesthesia provisions
- Medical orders
- Specialty services

# Medical Care Availability and Reduction of Error Act (MCARE) 40 P.S. § 1303.101et seq.

- Review of serious event, infrastructure failure and health care-associated infection reports to
  ensure accurate reporting and patient notification, employee training, prohibition of retaliatory
  action against health care workers for filing reports.
- Review patient safety plans for updating, accuracy, patient safety officer designation of duties and responsibilities.
- Review patient safety committee for appropriate composition, frequency of meetings, ensure minutes are kept of each monthly meeting.

# Child Protective Services Law 23 Pa.C.S. § 6344.2

- Check that newly hired employees who have "a significant likelihood of regular contact with children in the form of care, guidance, supervision or training" have undergone the necessary background checks.
- Ensure that the hospital has a policy to implement the requirements of the Act.

# Advance Health Care Directives 20 Pa.C.S. Ch. 54

- Ensure that the hospital has a policy that discusses both in-hospital and out-of-hospital advanced directives.
- Ensure that the policy addresses emergency medical services related to advance directives.
- Ensure that the policy addresses pregnancy services related to advance directives.
- Ensure that advance directive forms are kept in the medical record.
- Ensure that plans are in place to implement the decisions of the health care agent.

# Shaken Baby Syndrome Education Act

- Ensure that educational and instructional materials are available and distributed to parents of newborns.
- Ensure that the hospital has policy regarding compliance with the Act.
- Review medical records to ensure that signed commitment statements are contained in the records.
- Ensure that hospital staff is provided training in requirements of the Act.

# Safe Haven Act

• Review policies and procedures to ensure they comply with requirements of the Act regarding location for dropping off newborn babies and staff education is provided.

#### Sudden Infant Death Syndrome and Prevention Program

- Ensure that educational and instructional materials are available and distributed to parents of newborns.
- Ensure that the hospital has a policy regarding compliance with the Act.
- Review medical records to ensure that signed acknowledgement statement is contained in the records.
- Ensure that hospital staff is provided training in requirements of the Act.

#### Elderly Immunization Act

- Ensure that the hospital has a policy implementing the requirements of the Act -that persons over age 65 who are admitted to a hospital are given information that a vaccination for the influenza and pneumococcal disease is available and the individual are being given the opportunity to receive the vaccinations prior to discharge from the hospital.
- Review records to ensure that patients are being informed of the availability of the vaccine.

#### Circulating Nurse Act:

- Ensure that the hospital has a policy implementing the requirements of the Act-that a circulating nurse (who must be a licensed RN) is present in the operating room for every procedure that requires general anesthesia or deep sedation.
- Review records to ensure that a circulating nurse was present as required.
