The Department of Health's guidance for skilled nursing facilities dated 9/3/2020, conflicts were some aspects of CMS Memorandum (Ref. QSO-20-39-NH) dated 9/17/2020 regarding nursing home visitation. Which should our facility follow?	The Department of Health is reviewing the recent CMS Memorandums (Ref. QSO-20-38-NH dated 8/26/2020 and Ref. QSO-20-39-NH dated 9/3/2020) for purposes of updating existing guidance. If there is conflict between one of these CMS Memorandums and the guidance, follow the CMS Memorandum.		
In complying with the <u>Secretary of Health's</u> <u>Order</u> regarding personal protective equipment (issued 8/17/2020), our skilled nursing facility needs clarification about which respirators require fit testing and where we can obtain the fit test.	Fit testing is required for all filtering facepiece respirators. Skilled nursing facilities are encouraged to contact the Regional Response Health Collaboration program assigned to their facility for assistance with fit testing.

- If you travel to a state with a high number of COVID-19 cases, it is recommended that you stay at home for 14 days upon return to Pennsylvania. A <u>list of those states</u> has been created and is updated each Friday. On 9/25/2020, some states were added to the list while others were removed. The current list is as follows: Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Illinois, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Mississippi, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, Oklahoma, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, and Wisconsin.
