Trauma Informed Care: What Is Needed for Staff and Residents

This webinar will continue to follow this quarter's education theme, addressing workforce challenges. Components of trauma informed care and symptoms and behaviors which can indicate a history of traumatic stress exposure will be covered. Traumatic stress exposure is high in all populations and there needs to be consideration for its impact on staff and residents. Case examples will be used to highlight situations that can trigger trauma related symptoms for both staff and residents. Strategies to help manage trauma related reactions and behaviors will be reviewed.
